The Hong Kong Islamic Youth Association was established in 1973 by a group of motivated Muslim youth who have found a need to provide the youth with a platform to engage in community services and healthy lifestyle through various sports activities.

香港伊斯蘭青年協會是由一群熱心服務社會的穆斯林青年於1973年成立,他們發現 青年們需要一個可以推動他們參與社區服務的平台,並透過各式各樣的體育活動 來幫助他們建立健康的生活模式。

The Association is incorporated as a Limited Company by Guarantee under the Companies Ordinance and is also recognized as a Charitable Organization by the Inland Revenue Department.

At the same time, one of our goals is to also educate and inform people about Muslims and ethnic minorities, and removing the disastrous misconceptions that have been imaged and spread about the religion and the minorities group in Hong Kong.

The "Smile is Charity" campaign started in 2018 and we have held several promotion events in different locations, including high schools and university, different communities, mosques, etc. Passers-by or visitors rarely missed our colourful booth with attractive decorations, balloons and bright yellow smiley face props.

We want people to understand that even we don't have money to donate, a simple and sincere smile is also a good deed which will be accepted by Allah (SWT).

Some western media have introduced a distorted and unbalanced image of Islam, it is important to clarify the true Islam in order to avoid future misunderstanding. The public talk 'Does Islam Fuel Terrorism?' was arranged on 21st September at Masjid in collaboration with the Dawah Committee of the Islamic Union of Hong Kong. Around 45 participants attended the programme and acquired factual knowledge on the topic, thanks to the presentation by Br. Saadullah Sat. He distinguished between different terminologies associated with the topic, highlighted the peaceful nature of Islam from the Quran and Sunnah, Moreover, the talk also mentioned certain acts committed by a small minority in various different religions. We hope that Allah (SWT) will further enable all of us to do more to present the true image of Islam. Ameen.

Taekwondo Summer Class

暑期跆拳道體驗班

HKIYA was happy to have Y.E.S. of the Islamic Union of Hong Kong together in launching an Introductory Course on Taekwondo for our Muslim youth in July during the summer break. It was conducted by our Sister Nafeesa who is a qualified coach from Hong Kong Taekondo Association. This course included 4 sessions. There were a total of 16 participants, ranging from 5 to 15 years old. Through this course, it gave an opportunity for the youth to learn skills in Taekwondo, such as basic poomsae, front kicks, turning kicks, punches and block patterns. Through learning Taekwondo, participants could also build self-discipline, patience and self-confidence. Not only did the participants had fun and enjoyed the class but also their parents. Many parents stayed behind to give encouragement to their children. The 4 sessions were full of joy and laughter. Parents were thankful and appreciated to have Taekwondo class in the mosque. They hoped to have more sessions or advance courses in the future. This is a good chance for Muslim youth could have training both mentally and physically in the mosque.





ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND EXPLANATORY NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 AUGUST 2019

1 GENERAL INFORMATION

The Association, being a company limited by guarantee, was domiciled and incorporated in Hong Kong under the Companies Ordinance (Chap. 32) on 26 May 1999. Under the provisions of its memorandum and articles of association, every member shall, in the event of the Association being wound up, contribute to the assets of the Association to the extent of HK\$1. As at 31 August 2019, the Association had 423 registered members.

The Association is principally engaged in the promotion of Islamic principles and the encouragement of its members to study and practise Islam. The address of its registered office is 8/F., O.R. Sadick Islamic Centre, No. 40 Oi Kwan Road, Wanchai, Hong Kong.

These financial statements are presented in the functional currency, viz. Hong Kong dollars.

2 BASIS OF PREPARATION AND ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The Association qualifies for the reporting exemption as a small guarantee company under section 359(1) of the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance (Cap. 622) and is therefore entitled to prepare and present its financial statements in accordance with the Small and Medium-sized Entity Financial Reporting Standard (SME-FRS) issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants (HKICPA).

These financial statements comply with the SME-FRS and have been prepared under the accrual basis of accounting and on the basis that the Association is a going concern. The measurement base adopted is the historical cost convention.

The following are specific accounting policies that are necessary for a proper understanding of the financial statements:

(a) Revenue recognition

Provided that it is probable that the economic benefits associated with the revenue transaction will flow to the Association and the revenue and costs, if any, in respect of the transaction can be measured reliably, revenue is recognised as follows:

- Subscriptions and donations are recognised as revenue when the subscriptions or donations are received.
- (ii) Interest income is recognised on a time proportion basis taking into account the principal outstanding and the interest rate applicable.

ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND EXPLANATORY NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 AUGUST 2019 - continued

2 BASIS OF PREPARATION AND ACCOUNTING POLICIES - continued

(b) Property, plant and equipment

Property, plant and equipment are stated at historical cost less accumulated depreciation and impairment losses. Historical cost includes expenditure that is directly attributable to the acquisition of the items.

Subsequent expenditure is charged to the asset's carrying amount only when it is probable that future economic benefits associated with the item will flow to the Association and the cost of the item can be measured reliably. All other repairs and maintenance costs are expensed in the income statement during the financial period in which they are incurred.

Depreciation of property, plant and equipment is calculated using the straight line method to allocate cost to their residual values over their estimated useful lives. The annual rate of depreciation for furniture, fixtures and equipment is 20%.

The assets' residual values and useful lives are reviewed, and adjusted if appropriate, at each balance sheet date.

An asset's carrying amount is written down immediately to its recoverable amount if the asset's carrying amount is greater than its estimated recoverable amount.

(c) Investments in securities

Current investments are stated at the lower of cost and net realizable value. Long-term investments are stated at cost less accumulated impairment losses.

(d) Designated funds

All income accruing to and all expenses attributable to designated funds are accounted for directly in each particular fund.

The General Council have the discretion to use or transfer any funds in the furtherance of the objects of the Association except in instances where funds and donations when received for a specific purpose shall not be utilized for any other purpose without the prior approval of the donors.

(e) Foreign currency translation

Foreign currency transactions are translated into the functional currency using the exchange rate prevailing at the dates of the transactions. Foreign exchange gains and losses resulting from the settlement of such transactions and from the translation at year-end exchange rates of monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are recognised in the income statement.

(f) Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents include cash in hand, deposits held at call with banks and other short-term highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less.


