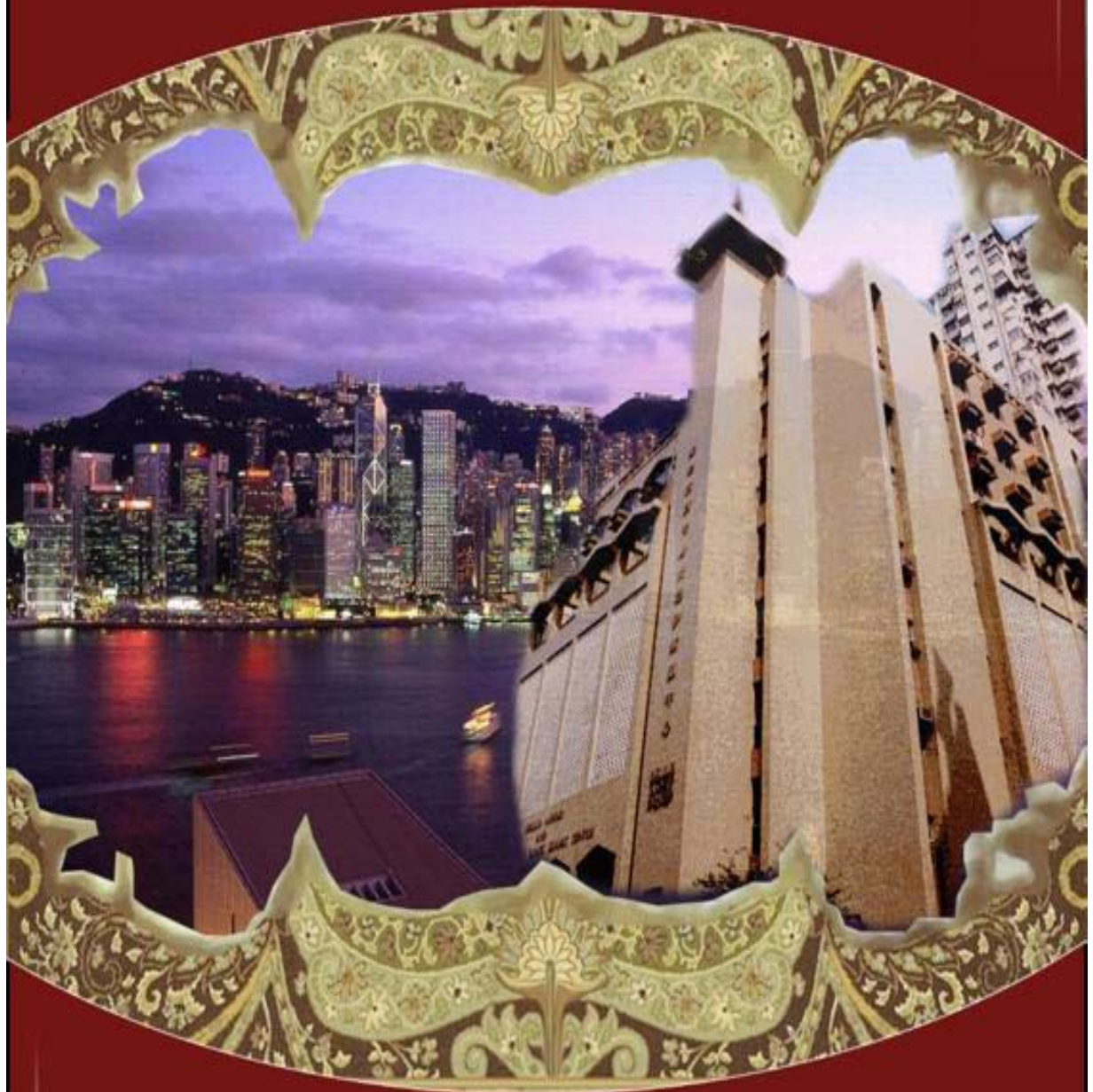


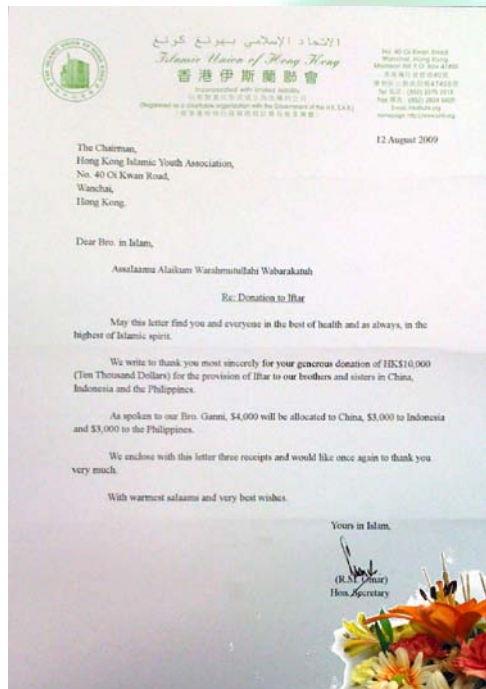
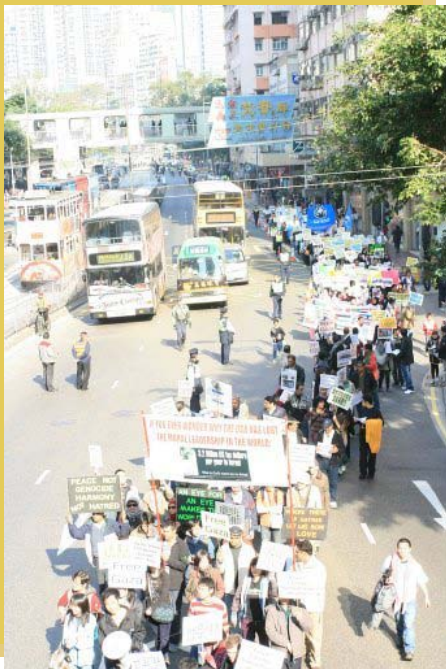

### **General Affairs**

#### **General Council**

#### **Library and Islamic Souvenirs**

3. We are continuing our limited library service for members. Islamic literatures, DVDs, CDs and audio/video cassette tapes are available for lending at our office during opening hours. We have also ordered some beautifully

designed scarves, prayer mats and prayer caps and you can buy them at attractive prices.

#### **Finance**

4. The total revenue for the financial year 2008-2009 was HK\$159,528 and the total expenditure was HK\$170,845. A deficit for the year of HK\$11,317 was recorded (HK\$11,510 from General Fund and HK\$193 from Designated funds). Please refer to the independent auditors' report to the members for details on page 13 to 26 in this report.

#### **Zakat**

5. The total Zakat collected during the year was HK\$114,052. Together with a balance brought forward of HK\$39,989, we have distributed the Zakat during the year as follows:

## **Cultural and Educational Activities**

### **Kowloon Masjid Open Day**

8. Council Members and Members of HKIYA volunteered in Kowloon Masjid Open Day, organized by Kowloon Masjid Da'wah Committee. The Open Day was held twice with Islamic talk and tour of Masjid. A good number of members turned out and insha'Allah in future more Open Days will be organized.

### **Workshop on Racial Discrimination Ordinance (RDO)**

9. Our Chairman Br. Mohamad Zaiq Ali attended the RDO Workshop organized by Equal Opportunities Commission on 29 August 2009. The workshop introduced the Racial Discrimination Bill to the Community.

## **Welfare Activities**

### **The 35<sup>th</sup> Annual Dinner**

10. On 27 Dec 2008, HKIYA organized its Annual Dinner in the canteen at the 5/F, O.R. Sadick Islamic Centre. Auction was held to raise fund for HKIYA activities. Attractive goods were sold and fabulous prizes were won by participants. To show our appreciation souvenirs were presented to volunteers. Over 100 persons participated in this event.

### **Dinner on 'HK Muslims in celebration of People's Republic of China 60th Anniversary Establishment & National Day'**

11. A celebration dinner for the 60th anniversary of the establishment of People's Republic of China was held at the Islamic Canteen on 24 September 2009. The function was jointly organized by four Muslim organizations in Hong Kong: Hong Kong Chinese Muslim Cultural & Fraternal Association, Hong Kong China Islamic Federation, Hong Kong Muslim Women Association and Hong Kong Islamic Youth Association. More than a hundred brothers and sisters attended the dinner that night.

### **UMAH Haji O. R. Sadick Care & Attention Home Visit**

12. A visit to the care and attention home was held on Sunday, 15 November 2009. The volunteers spent time talking with the elderly residents and gifts were distributed. We would like to express our appreciation to brothers and sisters that made a donation in supporting this meaningful activity.

### **Sponsor for Iftar & Dinner**

13. This year HKIYA sponsored Iftar to China, Philippines and Indonesia. Alhamdulillah! A greater number of needy brothers and sisters have benefited from the sponsorship. The donations were made through Islamic Union of HK.

### **Eid Carnival**

14. On 18 October 2009, Chinese Muslim Cultural and Fraternal Association held an Eid carnival at Islamic Kasim Tuet Memorial College in Chai Wan. Our Association was one of the participating organizations responsible for food stall and big sale. Beside Council Members, there were also other volunteers helping throughout the carnival, our Association would like to thank them for their tremendous help.

### **Health Talk on Common Eye Diseases**

15. HKIYA organized a health talk on common eye diseases on 14 March 2009. Our Council member Dr. Baig Nafees BEGUM (Ophthalmologist) was the speaker that day and she explained the cause and symptoms of some common eye diseases. A free eye check up was also offered to the participants after the talk.

## **Recreational Activities**

### **Spring Sports Day**

16. HKIYA organized a sports day on 22 February 2009. The Sports Day attracted a good number of brothers and sisters with a majority of youths. The weather was just fine that day and all participants enjoyed a pleasant day.

### **Summer Camp at Cheung Chau Island**

17. A youth summer camp was organized by HKIYA on 15-16 August, 2009 at Cheung Chau Holidays Villa. About 20 brothers and sisters from Hong Kong

attended the camp. The camp started with searching for Halal Foods in Supermarkets. The search was tough but we managed to get some Halal Foods. After the search, the youth went for beach-volleyball and followed by visit to the famous Cheung Chau Cave. A talk on “Relationship with Allah Almighty” by Br. Abu Bakr Ma was held. We learnt how to enhance our relationship with Allah Almighty and Prophet Muhammad (Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam). Of course, practising Islam is the essential step. Alhamdulillah, the camp was a success and insha’Allah in future we will strive to make it more successful and enjoyable.

## **Publication**

### **HKIYA Newsletter**

18. During the year, the Association has produced 2 issues of HKIYA Newsletter. This year we have uploaded the newsletter to our website as well. The publication team has also uploaded some handy pamphlets to the website. We pray and hope more brothers and sisters would come forward to help us in the publication of HKIYA, which served as a tool in promoting Islam and our Association to the local communities.

### **Received Books from Overseas Islamic Organizations**

19. During the year, our Association received Islamic books and magazines from some overseas Islamic Organizations including The Muslim Converts’ Association of Singapore, World Assembly of Muslim Youth and Conveying Islamic Message Society. We thank them for their consideration and generosity in providing us with the needed materials for our research, publication and dissemination. Moreover, we pray to Allah Almighty to reward them for their efforts in Islamic cause.

## **Public Relation**

### **Stop the Siege in Gaza**

20. More than 2,000 students, ethnic minorities and local peace-lovers took to the streets of Hong Kong on Sunday 11 January 2009 in a protest organised by Peace Aid to condemn Israel's attack on Gaza. The group, held placards and banners, marched from Victoria Park to the US Consulate General demanding the US stop supporting Israel's deadliest ever assault on the impoverished Gaza Strip. Felix Lam and Chris Ma (both from Hong Kong University) initiated the protest and HKIYA was amongst the first organizations to give them full support; without our application of Protest permit with Hong Kong Police this event would not have been possible.



### **Ethnic Minority Concern Group – RDO**

21. Our Chairman Br. Mohamad Zaiq Ali and Council Member Br. Khalid Faqir and others have joined partnership with other NGO's to promote the Racial Discrimination Ordinance, which has been enacted in July 2009. The aim of the group is to hold public awareness programs amongst the ethnic minorities' community and to promote racial harmony in Hong Kong.

### **Hong Kong Baptist University Interviewed HKIYA**

22. Local University students interviewed Our Chairman Br. Mohamad Zaiq ALI, and Council members Sr. Hanifah YU, Sr. Sarah MOOSA and teacher of IKTMC Sr. Zareenah HO in February 2009. The aim of the interview was to get to know more about Islamic Cultural and Muslim Youth in Hong Kong.

**INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF  
HONG KONG ISLAMIC YOUTH ASSOCIATION**

We have audited the financial statements of Hong Kong Islamic Youth Association set out on pages 14 to 26, which comprise the balance sheet as at 31 August 2009, and the income statement, statement of changes in funds and cash flow statement for the year then ended, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory notes.

**Directors' (general council members') responsibility for the financial statements**

The directors are responsible for the preparation and the true and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants and the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance. This responsibility includes designing, implementing and maintaining internal control relevant to the preparation and the true and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error; selecting and applying appropriate accounting policies; and making accounting estimates that are reasonable in the circumstances.

**Auditors' responsibility**

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit, and report solely to you, as a body, in accordance with section 141 of the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance, and for no other purpose. We do not assume responsibility towards or accept liability to any other person for the contents of this report. We conducted our audit in accordance with Hong Kong Standards on Auditing issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance as to whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditors' judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditors consider internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and true and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the directors, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

**Opinion**

In our opinion, the financial statements give a true and fair view of the state of the Association's affairs as at 31 August 2009 and of its deficit and cash flows for the year then ended in accordance with Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards and have been properly prepared in accordance with the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance.





## NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

### 1 GENERAL INFORMATION

The Association, being a company limited by guarantee, was domiciled and incorporated in Hong Kong under the Companies Ordinance on 26 May 1999. Under the provision of the Association's Memorandum and Articles of Association, every member shall, in the event of the Association being wound up, contribute to the assets of the Association to the extent of HK\$1. As at 31 August 2009, the Association had 229 registered members.

The Association is principally engaged in the promotion of Islamic principles and the encouragement of the members of the Association to study and practise Islam. The address of its registered office is 8/F., O.R. Sadick Islamic Centre, No. 40 Oi Kwan Road, Wanchai, Hong Kong.

These financial statements are presented in the functional currency, viz. Hong Kong dollars.

### 2 SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The principal accounting policies adopted in the preparation of these financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all the years presented, unless otherwise stated.

#### (a) Basis of preparation

- (i) The company's financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Hong Kong Financial Reporting standards (HKFRS). The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention, as modified by the financial assets and financial liabilities which are carried at fair value, or amortised cost, as appropriate.

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with HKFRS requires the use of certain critical accounting estimates. It also requires management to exercise its judgement in the process of applying the appropriate accounting policies of the Association. There are no areas involving a higher degree of judgement or complexity, or areas where assumptions and estimates are significant to the financial statements.

- (ii) Income and expenditure of the general fund and designated funds are included in the income statement in accordance with the HKAS 1 "Presentation of Financial Statements".

#### (b) Revenue recognition

Provided that it is probable that the economic benefits associated with the revenue transaction will flow to the Association and the revenue and costs, if any, in respect of the transaction can be measured reliably, revenue is recognised as follows:

- (i) Subscriptions and donations are recognised as revenue when the subscriptions or donations are received.
- (ii) Interest income is recognised on a time proportion basis taking into account the principal outstanding and the interest rate applicable.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS - continued

2 SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES - continued

(c) Property, plant and equipment

Property, plant and equipment are stated at historical cost less accumulated depreciation and impairment losses. Historical cost includes expenditure that is directly attributable to the acquisition of the items.

Subsequent expenditure is charged to the asset's carrying amount only when it is probable that future economic benefits associated with the item will flow to the Association and the cost of the item can be measured reliably. All other repairs and maintenance costs are expensed in the income statement during the financial period in which they are incurred.

Depreciation of property, plant and equipment is calculated using the straight line method to allocate cost to their residual values over their estimated useful lives. The annual rate of depreciation for furniture, fixtures and equipment is 20%.

The assets' residual values and useful lives are reviewed, and adjusted if appropriate, at each balance sheet date.

An asset's carrying amount is written down immediately to its recoverable amount if the asset's carrying amount is greater than its estimated recoverable amount.

(d) Investments in available-for-sale financial assets

Available-for-sale financial assets are included in non-current assets unless management intends to dispose of the investment within 12 months of the balance sheet date. They are carried at fair value. Unrealized gains and losses arising from changes in the fair value of non-monetary securities classified as available-for-sale are recognised in equity. When securities classified as available-for-sale are sold or impaired, the accumulated fair value adjustments are included in the income statement as gain or losses from investment securities.

(e) Designated funds

All income accruing to and all expenses attributable to a designated fund are accounted for directly in each particular fund.

The General Council have the discretion to use or transfer any funds in the furtherance of the objects of the Association except in instances where funds and donations when received for a specific purpose shall not be utilized for any other purpose without the prior approval of the donors.

(f) Foreign currency translation

Foreign currency transactions are translated into the functional currency using the exchange rate prevailing at the dates of the transactions. Foreign exchange gains and losses resulting from the settlement of such transactions and from the translation at year-end exchange rates of monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are recognised in the income statement.

(g) Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents include cash in hand, deposits held at call with banks and other short-term highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less.

3 FINANCIAL RISK MANAGEMENT

The Association's activities expose it to credit risk and liquidity risk as described below. The Association's overall risk management policies focus on minimising the potential adverse effects on the Association by closely monitoring the individual exposure as follows:

(i) Credit risk

The Association has no significant concentrations of credit risk. It has policies in place to ensure that income from membership subscription and other events are primarily collected in cash.

(ii) Liquidity risk

The Association's policy is to regularly monitor current and expected liquidity requirements to ensure that it maintains sufficient reserves of cash and cash equivalents to meet its liquidity requirements in the short and longer term.

(iii) Fair value estimation

The nominal value less estimated credit adjustments of account receivables and payables are assumed to approximate their fair values.

### 少數族裔關注組 - 種族歧視法
