2. HKIYA was glad to have sister Sr. Zainab Ho as Office Helper this year from February to September 2014. She contributed to the daily office work as well

as the activities organized during this year. She received a very minimal transportation allowance from the Association. HKIYA would like to sincerely thank her for her selfless sacrifices, time and efforts in contributing to the success of all the events and activities in this year.

Library and Islamic Souvenirs

3. Islamic literatures, DVDs and CDs in our library are available for lending at our office during opening hours. Some other books are being distributed free and are available at our 8/F office. We have also ordered beautiful scarves, prayer mats, and prayer caps which are all available at our office at attractive prices.

Finance

4. For the financial year 2013-2014, the total revenue amounted to HK\$ 605,067 while the total expenditure was HK\$573,778 (including a fair value gain on available-for-sale financial assets of HK\$27,139). A surplus for the financial year of HK\$31,289 was recorded (comprising of HK\$52,070 from General fund and a deficit of HK\$20,781 from Designated funds). Donation by Ng Teng Fong Charitable Foundation Limited

5. In Jan 2014, HKIYA received a donation of HK\$100,000 from Ng Teng Fong Charitable Foundation Limited for supporting our charity work.

Membership

Youth Development Fund

9. HKIYA set up a "Youth Development Fund (Student)" ("YDF"), which was implemented in December, 2011. The target group for this YDF is full-time students not over the age of 22 and in need of financial subsidy to join our events and activities. We aim to encourage or assist youth in need so that they can join our events and activities without financial restriction. HKIYA has continuously made use of this fund to aid students in need over the year 2014.

Individual Major Projects <u>Cultural and Educational Activities</u>

Visit to the Hong Kong Museum of Art

10. HKIYA organized an art visit at the Hong Kong Museum of Art on 17th May, 2014. We took a guided tour to visit a famous exhibit of Ju Ming called

"Sculpting the Living World" and other permanent art exhibitions at the museum. There were a lot sculptures, abstract paintings and some modern art, all created by different aspired artists. Our participants for this trip were mostly Indonesian sisters; they were very interested in those art pieces and. They felt that they had learnt more about the culture of Hong Kong with this event.

Pre-Ramadan Workshop

11. The 2014 Pre-Ramadan Workshop was jointly organized by HKIYA and Chinese Muslim Cultural & Fraternal Association (CMCFA), for Muslims to understand and prepare for Ramadan, in the middle of June at CMCFA. We invited Imam Noorudin Yang as our speaker. During the workshop, he recited Surah Al-Fatihah and Surah Ya sinn from the Quran. He also taught us the importance of Ramadan and what we have to do during Ramadan. After that, we carried out group discussions and made a small group for women to ask Imam Yang's wife questions regarding Ramadan. Overall, we learnt a lot in this workshop.

Visit to Haji Omar Ramju Sadick Care and Attention Home

12. Each year, HKIYA gathers volunteers to visit the elderly at Haji Omar Ramju Sadick Care and Attention Home in Tuen Mun. This year, 20 volunteers visited them during the Chinese New Year on 3rd February 2014. We chatted, played games, sang songs and distributed "red-pockets" to the elderly. Everybody had a great time.

Interview with Students

13. In March, there were five students from the Chinese University of Hong Kong who visited HKIYA in order to learn more about Islam. Two council members represented HKIYA to meet them at HKIYA office. We introduced Islamic history and the situation of Islam in Hong Kong to them, and also answered some questions raised by the students. We did a tour of the Wan Chai mosque and introduced them to Imam Yeung. Over the year, there were also other students who inquired about Islam, all which we gladly answered.

Ramadan Children Class at CMCFA

14. About 20 children participated in the class which was held during the

month of Ramadan on 1/F of Chinese Muslim Cultural and Fraternal Association (CMCFA). The children were taught how to do ablution before prayer and how to perform prayer including the azan (call for prayer). After the class, the children and their parents also had Iftar at CMCFA. These classes were jointly organized with CMCFA.

Welfare Activities

HKIYA 40th Anniversary Celebration and Annual Dinner

15. On 28th December 2013, HKIYA held its 40th Anniversary Celebration and Annual Dinner at 5/F, O.R.S. Islamic Centre. We offered attractive prizes for participants of the Annual Dinner. More than 130 guests attended. Each participant also received a copy of our 40th anniversary special booklet.

Zakat to Poor Muslims in Syria, Gaza and Philippines

16. HKIYA has distributed Zakat in Syria, Gaza and Philippines to provide the people with basic needs such as food, water and other essentials.

Zakat to Poor Muslims during Ramadan

17. The Association has distributed Zakat through the Islamic Union of Hong Kong and other organizations to poor Muslims in Pakistan, Syria, China, India, Philippines and Indonesia during Ramadan this year.

<u>Charity Movie Show – Fundraising for Syrian Refugees Part 1</u>

18. On 29th March, we organized a charity movie show for fundraising for Syrian Refugees. A film named "SELAM" was shown to the audience. It is a touching and inspirational Turkish movie about 3 young teachers who live for their ideals and other people before themselves. After the show, a film review session was led by Br. Rusian Yusupov. About 30 brothers and sisters joined this event.

Charity Sales and Food Feast - Fundraising for Syrian Refugees Part 2

19. On 13th April, 2014, HKIYA organized another fundraising event for Syrian Refugees, Charity Sales and Food Feast co-organised by the Islamic Union of Hong Kong. More than 80 brothers and sisters joined this event. Everyone

enjoyed the food donated by various organisations and donated generously. We would like to thank everyone who donated food and money to make the event successful.

Gaza Charity Bazaar

20. HKIYA held a two-day Bazaar with numerous other organizations in September at 8/F, Masjid Ammar. Good sold included home appliances, clothing, stationary and jewelry. We thank all donors for contributing to this event.

Public Relation

Visit to Guangzhou

21. All the Islamic associations of HK, including HKIYA, were invited to visit Guangzhou for a seminar from 26th to 27th of August in 2014. On the first day, they provided us with a feast and invited us to join their special program which was a doctrine speech competition. It was a very exciting competition. On the second day, we attended another meeting and shared our opinions for peace between two places, China & Hong Kong, and peace of religion. This meeting process was a special experience as it enhanced mutual understanding.

Visit by Malaysian University Students

22. The students of Islamic Banking from the University Technology of MARA, Malaysia had an educational trip to Hong Kong in August and met representatives of HKIYA on 17 August on 6/F of ORS Islamic Centre. We gave our guests a presentation to highlight the history of HKIYA followed by a Question and Answer session related to investments of Hong Kong Muslims. Our guests from Malaysia enjoyed some refreshments afterwards.

Samaritan Bookmarks in Bahasa

23. This year, with our Indonesian sisters and brothers in mind, HKIYA obtained consent from the Samaritans to sponsor the Samaritans 24-hours hotline bookmarks printed in Bahasa language. HKIYA has distributed most of the bookmarks. We hope to aid our Muslims brothers and sisters in any way that we can.

Workshops by Junior Chamber International Hong Kong

24. Five HKIYA members participated in the "start your own business" Workshop. This workshop was organized by Junior Chamber International Hong Kong (JCI) and they invited HKIYA as a supporting organization. There were three sessions in total. At the end of the second session, participants could submit their business plan. The best three business plans would get a prize worth \$9,000. There were also experience sharing and strategy sharing sessions held by successful entrepreneurs and professionals. This event helped increase the publicity of HKIYA. Members also had a chance to network with members of other organizations, especially those of JCI, and learn about setting up their own business.

Joint Muslim Living Camp

25. On May 10th to 11th, we joined a camp which was jointly organized by five different Muslim organizations in Hong Kong, including HKIYA. The camp was held at Tai Mei Tuk. Group discussions with explanation by Imam Noorudin, Yang Xin Wen facilitated us to exchange knowledge about Islam among each other. Alhamdulillah, about 60 brothers and sisters attended the event, including a group from Shenzhen.

Eid Carnival at Islamic Kasim Tuet Memorial College

26. HKIYA was pleased to take part in the Family Eid Fun Fair organized on 18th October, 2014 by Islamic Kasim Tuet Memorial College. HKIYA had a stall for selling clothes and ornaments.

Children Eid-ul-Fitr Party 2014

28. This year's Children Eid-ul-Fitr Party was jointly organized by HKIYA and the Islamic Union of Hong Kong, and held on 3rd August, 2014. The party consisted of multiple exciting group games and a lot of food and presents. There was also a lucky draw at the end. Everyone had a great time and went home with high spirits.

Bowling Day

29. It was organised on 29th March, 2014 at the Disciplined Services Sports and Recreation Club. Participants competed with each other and exchanged their bowling skills. Everyone enjoyed a fun morning.

Eid-ul-Adha Lunch Buffet

30. During this year's Eid-ul-Adha, HKIYA organized an Eid lunch buffet on 5th October, 2014. Our members participated with enthusiasm and the tickets were sold in no time. Everybody enjoyed the Indian food while they chatted with each other. Some lucky participants also won our lucky draw prizes.

Indoor War Game for Fun

31. An Indoor War Game event for fun was held on 21st June, 2014. Students from Islamic Kasim Tuet Memorial College and other Muslim youth joined enthusiastically. Most students were sponsored from the Youth Development Fund. This 3-hour long activity allowed Muslim youth to communicate with each other, and learn teamwork and co-operation.

Sisters Cycling Day

32. HKIYA organized and sponsored a bicycle day for girls from the IKTMC in April. This activity aimed to allow Muslim girls to enjoy outdoor cycling on a nice sunny day in Spring. The event was popular and seats were filled up quickly. Two council members together with two teachers from IKTMC led the group for a wonderful day.

Some cultural practices make it difficult for girls to participate in outdoor activities such as cycling and outings. Therefore, the group enjoyed it very

much and cherished the time they had together that day. Alhamdulillah, the sisters cycling day was full of fun and laughter without any injuries. Some of the participants had limited cycling experience. However, with the leaders teaching them, they enjoyed the cycling day with ease.

Publication

33. HKIYA has been publishing its own newsletter since its inception in 1973. The newsletters are aimed to deliver knowledge of Islam and spread the culture of Islam to the youth and members in the community. INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF HONG KONG ISLAMIC YOUTH ASSOCIATION

We have audited the financial statements of Hong Kong Islamic Youth Association ("the Association") set out on pages 2 to 11, which comprise the balance sheet as at 31 August 2014, and the statement of income, statement of changes in funds and cash flow statement for the year then ended, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

Directors' (general council members') responsibility for the financial statements

The directors are responsible for the preparation of financial statements that give a true and fair view in accordance with the Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standard for Private Entities issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants and the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance, and for such internal control as the directors determine is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit, and report solely to you, as a body, in accordance with section 141 of the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance, and for no other purpose. We do not assume responsibility towards or accept liability to any other person for the contents of this report. We conducted our audit in accordance with Hong Kong Standards on Auditing issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation of financial statements that give a true and fair view in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the directors, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

1 GENERAL INFORMATION

The Association, being a company limited by guarantee, was domiciled and incorporated in Hong Kong under the Companies Ordinance on 26 May 1999. Under the provisions of its memorandum and articles of association, every member shall, in the event of the Association being wound up, contribute to the assets of the Association to the extent of HK\$1. As at 31 August 2014, the Association had 252 registered members.

The Association is principally engaged in the promotion of Islamic principles and the encouragement of its members to study and practise Islam. The address of its registered office is 8/F., O.R. Sadick Islamic Centre, No. 40 Oi Kwan Road, Wanchai, Hong Kong.

These financial statements are presented in the functional currency, viz. Hong Kong dollars.

2 BASIS OF PREPARATION AND ACCOUNTING POLICIES

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standard for Private Entities (HKFRS for Private Entities) issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants (HKICPA) and the requirements of the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance. They have been prepared under the historical cost convention, as modified by the revaluation of financial assets which are carried at fair value.

(a) Revenue recognition

Provided that it is probable that the economic benefits associated with the revenue transaction will flow to the Association and the revenue and costs, if any, in respect of the transaction can be measured reliably, revenue is recognised as follows:

- Subscriptions and donations are recognised as revenue when the subscriptions or donations are received.
- (ii) Interest income is recognised on a time proportion basis taking into account the principal outstanding and the interest rate applicable.

(b) Property, plant and equipment

Property, plant and equipment are stated at historical cost less accumulated depreciation and impairment losses. Historical cost includes expenditure that is directly attributable to the acquisition of the items.

Subsequent expenditure is charged to the asset's carrying amount only when it is probable that future economic benefits associated with the item will flow to the Association and the cost of the item can be measured reliably. All other repairs and maintenance costs are expensed in the income statement during the financial period in which they are incurred.

Depreciation of property, plant and equipment is calculated using the straight line method to allocate cost to their residual values over their estimated useful lives. The annual rate of depreciation for furniture, fixtures and equipment is 20%.

The assets' residual values and useful lives are reviewed, and adjusted if appropriate, at each balance sheet date.

An asset's carrying amount is written down immediately to its recoverable amount if the asset's carrying amount is greater than its estimated recoverable amount.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS - continued

2 BASIS OF PREPARATION AND ACCOUNTING POLICIES - continued

(c) Investments in available-for-sale financial assets

Available-for-sale financial assets are included in non-current assets unless management intends to dispose of the investment within 12 months of the balance sheet date. They are carried at fair value with changes in fair value recognised in the income statement. When securities classified as available-for-sale are sold or impaired, the accumulated fair value adjustments are included in the income statement as gain or losses from investment securities.

(d) Designated funds

All income accruing to and all expenses attributable to designated funds are accounted for directly in each particular fund.

The General Council have the discretion to use or transfer any funds in the furtherance of the objects of the Association except in instances where funds and donations when received for a specific purpose shall not be utilized for any other purpose without the prior approval of the donors.

(e) Foreign currency translation

Foreign currency transactions are translated into the functional currency using the exchange rate prevailing at the dates of the transactions. Foreign exchange gains and losses resulting from the settlement of such transactions and from the translation at year-end exchange rates of monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are recognised in the income statement.

(f) Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents include cash in hand, deposits held at call with banks and other short-term highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less.
